End of term

Curriculum News

Children have thoroughly enjoyed their topics this term and have proudly shared the result of their hard work in many ways:

EYFS have performed a Christmas play. Also celebrated and tasted food for Diwali, Bonfire night and Hull Fair.

Y1 have been working hard to learn new phonic sounds, which they have used when developing their story writing skills. They have also been thinking about seasonal changes and been learning about the Gunpowder Plot.

Y2 have enjoyed learning about life in a medieval castle. We have had lots of fun playing in our castle, having banquets, fighting dragons and rescuing Princesses! We also created our very own castle fact file for the library.

Y3 have produced a book for the school library, taken part in a whole class dance, progressed their cricket skills, painted some African sunsets, created crafts for the Christmas Fair and learnt all about living a healthy and active lifestyle.

Y4 This term the children have enjoyed writing a Mayan playscript which they will be performing to their phase. They have learnt about the history of chocolate. In Science and DT they have enjoyed looking at how materials change and have made some chocolate treats to sell on a 'Fair Trade' stall at the Christmas Fair.

Y5 have thoroughly enjoyed learning about WW2 over the autumn term, culminating in a fantastic performance to parents. £30 was raised in donations, which will be split between the Royal British Legion and additions to the school's library.

Y6 have studied how Ancient Greece has had an influence on our modern world by conducting research, artwork, diary entries and role-play activities.

They have also created a Science TV video to show our understanding on how to classify living things.
