

Uniform

A gentle reminder that children need to come to school in the correct uniform outlined on the School's Uniform website. This includes:

- Blue or white shirt, blouse or polo shirt
- Royal blue jumper, sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece
- Grey or black trousers, skirt or shorts
 - Black school shoes only

PE

In Year 1, PE takes place every Tuesday & Thursday. We recommend children bring their PE kits on a Monday and leave them in school for the full week in case we have to move our PE sessions around.

Please can you ensure your child has the correct PE kit. This includes: a pair of black shorts, a black T-shirt or a black shirt in their PE kit. Children with pierced ears, need to bring tape to cover their earrings during PE or remove them to prevent injury. Long hair should also be tied back.

The Daily Mile

Every day, every class will take part in a minute jog. This is not a competition and is for the children personally how fast they like to jog.

There is no need for the children to get changed into their PE kits, however suitable footwear is required for the children to be comfortable running 15 minutes.
