The children will have a range of creative adventure writing opportunities. We will then move onto non-fiction writing.</li> <li>• For Reading, we will undertake an in-depth study on the class book, practising key skills and unseen texts throughout the week.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Number and place value: comparing and ordering numbers to 10 million.</li> <li>• Multiplication, division, subtraction and addition: Key skills and formal written methods.</li> <li>• Fractions: Identifying and finding fractions of numbers.</li> <li>• Geometry: Position and direction, plotting coordinates on a quadrant.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In Science, we will begin by learning about living things and their habitats. This will include different types of classification and using these to judge animals by their characteristics.</li> <li>• We will then move onto evolution, learning about how living things change over time and how we can find evidence for this.</li> </ul>
