<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Rainforests are located near the equator in between the tropics of Cancer and the tropics of Capricorn. 2. There are 4 layers of a rainforest emergent, canopy, understory, and forest floor. 3. Farming and tribes are a cause of deforestation. 4. foods such as avocados, coconuts, grapefruit, bananas, guavas and pineapples come from or originate from rainforests 5. More than 10,000 species of plants and animals are at high risk of extinction due to the destruction of the Amazon rainforest
