'Is my child well-enough to come to school?'







It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell.

Find out when it's best to keep your sick child at home and when it's best to send them to school.

Please **REMEMBER** when leaving a message stating your child will **NOT** be in **school/nursery** that you leave a **REASON** why so the correct code can be given on the register.

<u>Medical appointments</u> Please try to book any medical appointments outside of school hours. either after school, across lunchtime or in the school holidays. Any appointments taken during the school day MUST be supported by documentary evidence such as a letter, screenshot or email of the appointment.
