We would like to say a huge thank you for all of your donations and support. Without your kindness, this wonderful space would not have been possible.

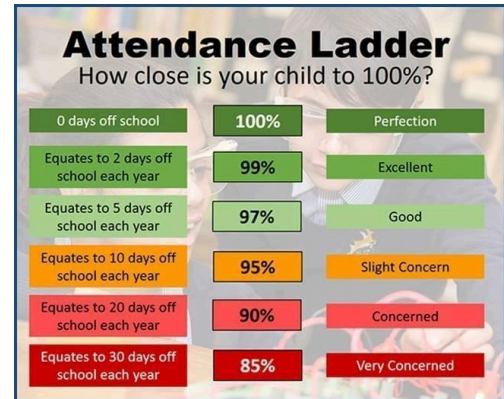
We also have some lovely ideas in the pipeline for the future, including a memory tree and a 'fish wish pond', which we are very excited about developing with the children.
